

Visa Information

Participants from EU countries do not need a visa to attend the course.

Participants from **Canada, USA, Australia, and New Zealand** can attend the course on a **90 day tourist visa**, which is issued automatically upon arrival in Germany.

Participants from most other countries must apply for a visa. **When booking your course, please consider that you will need to allow enough time for visa processing.** Check with your local German Embassy for detailed information on obtaining the necessary visa.

Once you have paid your deposit, please email Viola.Keller@inlingua-leipzig.de and we will issue a confirmation letter that you will need for your visa appointment.

If you want to **work abroad**, you will need a **work permit**, depending on your citizenship and in which country you want to work. If you want to stay in Germany, you will need make an appointment at the local Foreigner Authority Office (Ausländerbehörde). We suggest making the appointment as soon as you are in Germany.
